- 7) From the visitor's moorings income £120.00 pa is set aside per mooring for replacement tackle when required so there is a contingency fund carried forward from previous years from 2011 to 2017 that is included in the surplus.
- 8) The website was upgraded inc mobile phone functionality and compliance with GDPR regulations implemented. The Wi-Fi Antenna was also upgraded total cost was £900
